Session Evaluations

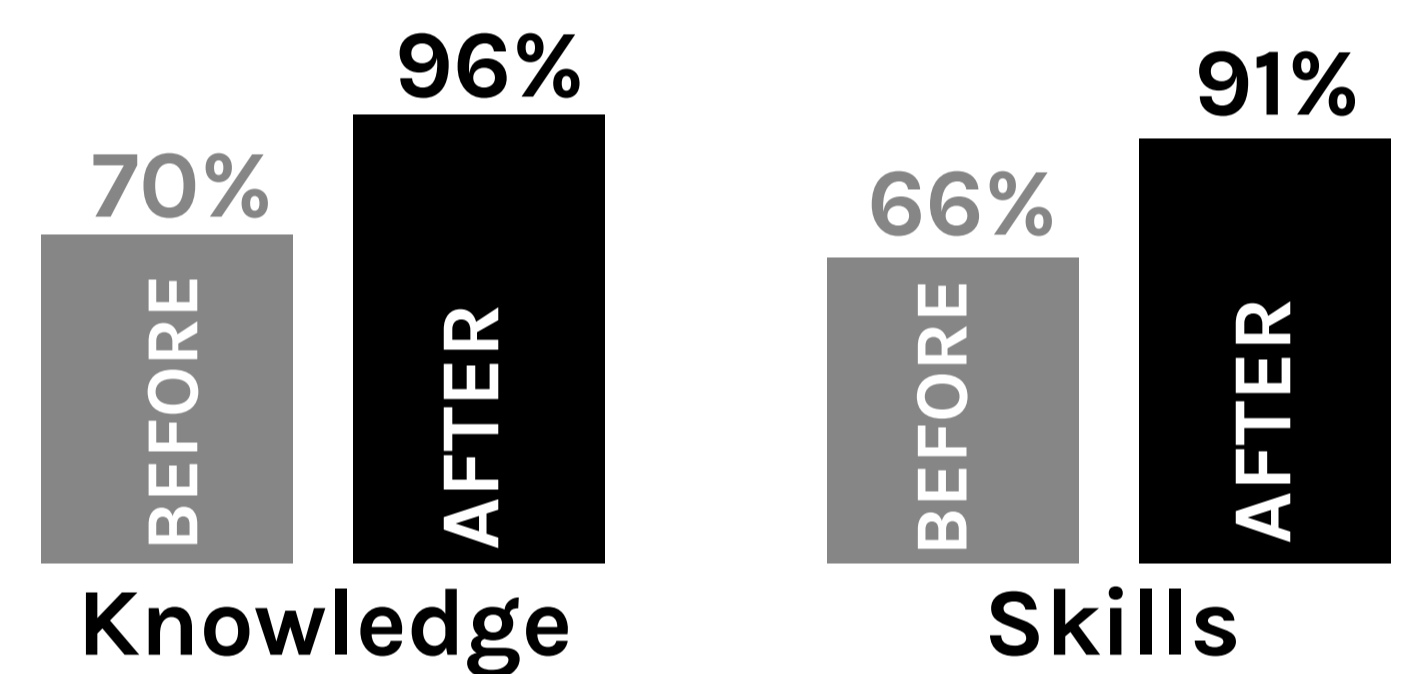
823 session evaluations were completed over 39 sessions.

85% or more noted didactics were relevant/useful.

75% or more noted problem of practices were relevant/useful.

Pre & Post Network Survey

95 participants completed the post-survey.

43 participants completed skill ratings on both the retrospective pre- and post-survey.

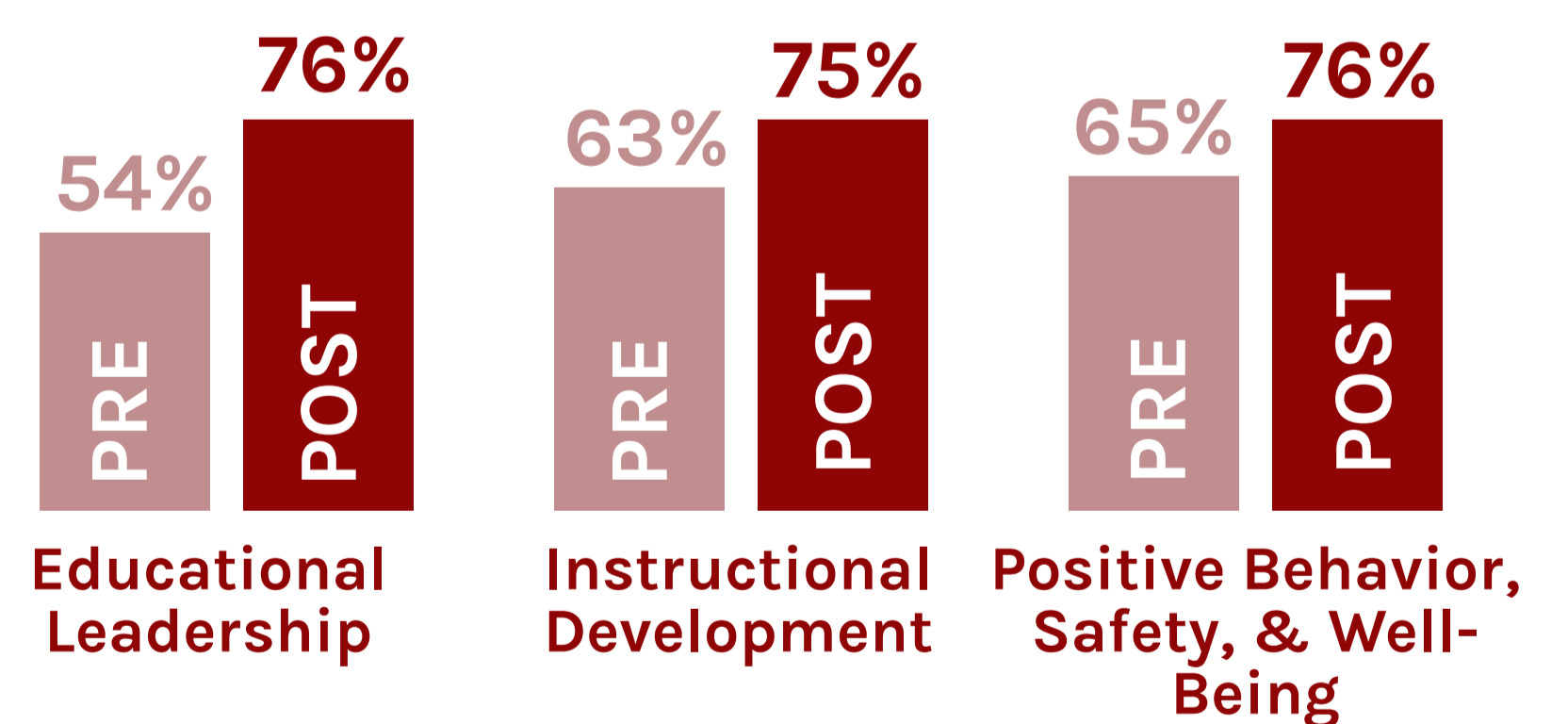
84% shared information from sessions.

71% made changes to their practice.

65% implemented something they learned in the classroom.

Phone Interviews

26 participants were interviewed about their experiences related to the ECHO sessions.
